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Melting Ice Science Experiment

Ice cubes are a subject of intense fascination for many young children. You can start by filling an ice tray with water and a dash of food coloring. Stick the tray into a freezer and once the cubes are formed, show kids how to use some warm water to pry the cubes out of the tray. Now, ask kids to sprinkle salt on these cubes and watch the ice melt and the shapes they form! You can also drop some of the ice cubes into a jar with oil and watch it melt.



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
